

Hainesville Emergency Management Re-Start Meeting

May 26th, 2011

Meeting to order at 7 :04 pm

In attendance was Linda Soto, Jim Rock (ancilGlink), Mike Benko, Mark Typln, Wally Kreese, Jeff Gatley and Kevin Barrett

Opening statements by Mr. Benko included thanking everyone for coming and this is an over due meeting but glad to see EMA coming together again

We have now an update EOP on file with all governing agencies and that as we restart we will be a little constrained by budget limitations this year

Jim Rock the spoke on the Review of liability and the legal aspects of EMA and how it is brought to fruition by local ordinance and said although EMA act gives the ability to establish an agency there are no rules that say don't have to have an EMA or ordinance covers EMA with limitations in state and local jurisdictions . We don't interfere with the larger agencies unless a larger ordinance supersedes our jurisdiction.

Our EOP has been signed off by county, and the plan covers / Food. Clothing Ishelter Inecessities need for human and animal survival and our EOP meets IEMA standards. There will be a bi-annual review

Plan is not beyond the scope of Local Police / Fire and other services to help in mitigation or relief in a disaster.

Plan also relies on local level Unified command and of the incident cobvering all village departments, the EOP will be activated by the mayor \ All Cordination reports to the Mayor & it's liaison

The EMA comments included the need for the village to put in place E- Vac & fire drill plans in place as a program

To continue to monitor and observe terrorism threat levels / issues

New communication equipment will be arriving shortly and that the EMA will be housed in the old public works garage behind the village hall

Next step is to start resource planning, donations of equipment and start drills for training and put an article in the news letter looking for donations in search of additional equipment and supplies

A survey will be sent out to see what date would be agreeable to all parties for a once a month meeting
