- 1) This is the first meeting in approximately 2 years so there are no minutes to approve or Old Business to discuss.
- 2) Future meetings will be held on the fourth Tuesday of each month at 6:15 at the Village Hall.
- 3) Trustee Kriese noted that the School's Open signs had been placed around the Village.
- 4) Committee projects, at present, include:
 - a. Researching a solution for the crosswalk at Tall Oak Drive and Hainesville Road.
 - b. Locating a place of purchase for and purchasing fold up stop signs for the 12 stop lights in the Village.
 - c. Investigating a method that will protect bike path users from the steep drop off located east of the path and approximately 150' south of Washington Street.

Trustee Kriese has contacted Mr. Burke, a LCDOT engineer, regarding the crosswalk and will have future discussions with him regarding items b and c.

- 5) Trustee Kriese indicated that he feels that the purpose of the Public Safety Committee is to educate the community on safety issues and to deal with the citizens' concerns and question on safety related issues.

He suggested that we look into sponsoring or co-sponsoring, with appropriate agencies, workshops on issues such as gangs, safety, and emergency related topics.
