Minutes from previous meeting approved.

Pedestrian Crossing at Tall Oak and Hainesville Rd:

Trustee Kriese received two quotes on the RRFB, one from Spot Devices (\$8,970) and the other from Eltec Corp (\$7,700). Both are comparable with each other in price but Spot Devices has a System Infrastructure Management Application (SIMA) feature. This is a browser-based tool for remote supervision of all Spot Device systems. Talked with Mark Stonikas, Civil Engineer from Crystal Lake, about their installation of Spot Device's RRFB which they have been using the since late last year. They are very pleased and have bought a second system for another intersection. I had the chance to look at their system and found it to be exactly what we're looking for.

Also, I was at a LCML meeting on Oct. 20, 2011 and had the chance to talk to both Jon Nelson and Paula Trigg. They gave Trustee Kriese the direction to acquire the permits for the installation of the RRFB. A decision now needs to be made.

Bike Path on Hainesville Rd:

A request for service was sent on Oct. 19,2011 and a reply, that the Maintenance Foreman was going to inspect it, was sent. No further updates.

Public Works has not received quote from Chris Electric as of yet.
