Old business: We continued discussion of short and long term projects for the Wetland Committee to consider. We discussed each projects, its priority, and budget.

Mention was made of some of the suggestions from residents as a result of the article in the Haineville Newsletter asking suggestions for projects they would like the Wetland Committee to consider. One resident was concerned about the woodland between Washington St. and Big Horn East.

Dave Coulter and I will attend the Cranberry North Townhome Association January board meeting to discuss the four acres of woodland at the western edge of their property.

The village attorney had concerns about putting in a stairway at the south end of Triumph Court in Cranberry North as part of correcting the erosion problem there. Jeff Gately, Dave Coulter and I met at the site to determine how much land is involved in reducing the slope to help with the erosion and make access to the Cranberry lake path easier for Cranberry North residents.


A letter describing the plan was sent to Don Heiden, president of Cranberry North c/o the property manager.
