

Community Relations Meeting Minutes

April 4th, 2012

The meeting was called to order at 1:08 pm.

Attendees: Trustee John Derenoski, Chairman; Mayor Soto, Public Works Superintendent Jeff Gately and Village Clerk Kathy Metzler.

The February 28th, 2012 and the March 28th, 2012 Community Relations Meeting minutes were approved by Clerk Metzler and seconded by John Derenoski.

Mayor Soto will give the addresses to us next week so the sponsors letters can be mailed out for Hainesville Fest.

May 19th will be the ribbon cutting for the new pike path at 9:00 a.m. with Paula Trigg and Marty Buehler from Lake County DOT. Linda suggested having Margaret Bucich cut the ribbon. Linda has confirmed with Mobil Eye that they will conduct the traffic duty for this morning event. We will have two tents set up in front of the Public Works Building one with bike helmets, rules of the road and water bottles and the other tent will have coffee and verbiage for the electronic recycling that same day. We will order a big pair of scissors and ribbon and the scissors will be given to Margaret. Jeff will have two steaks in the ground for the ribbon cutting on the bike path that morning.

Mayor Soto has a quote from 4 imprint minimum order of 120 water bottles for \$277.; and for a bike recycled bottle 200 for \$304. Trustee Derenoski called ArtRageous for a quote for 50 water bottles. He will call Starbucks to see if they can donate coffee and treats for the ribbon cutting.

SWALCO will provide us with signage. Jeff will need to have 6 to 12 people to help residents take the electronic items out of their cars.

8:00 a.m. to noon for the SWALCO electronics and then the ribbon cutting at 9:00 a.m.

Hiring the bands was discussed. We are waiting on one more DVD from a band and then a decision will be made.

Linda will talk to Phil at Wine Knows regarding Hainesville Fest. Tres Flores and Bill Gentes is a go and we will have free popcorn. Jeff will talk with Joe at the American Legion Hall regarding the Ladies Auxiliary volunteering to cook the food. The village will purchase all the food and the Legion Hall will reimburse us. We will do double the food we did last year. Exhibitors – (who sells their wares) Hainesville Residents will be charged \$10.; and \$50 for a non-resident. Vendors (who sells food) no charge.

Mayor Soto asked Trustee Derenoski if he met with Doug Williams regarding the 5K event which will begin and end at Hainesville Fest. John needs from Doug the insurance and other information. Linda stated that Doug will have to hire the people who tracks the runners; this is a two mile race.

The April 4th, 2012 Community Relations meeting adjourned at 2:00 p.m.
