Old Business:

Pedestrian Crossing at Tall Oak and Hainesville Rd:

The funds for this project were put into the Public Works Budget for this year. The applications and fees for the permit on this project were received and given to Public Works, Jeff Gately.

The safety hazard along the bike path between Big Horn and Washington has been repaired as of December 4, 2011.

The funds for the backup generators were also put into the Public Works Budget, also.

New Business:

Discussion:
