Old Business:


1. One of the viburnum shrub at Deer Point died. Dave Coulter put in two button bushes to check if the viburnum was a problem or if we still have herbicide issues. We will know later this summer.
2. The bubble tubing has been installed at the Lisk pond and it, along with algaecide has made a significant difference in the water quality of the pond.
3. The drainpipe has still not been installed in Hainesville Meadow. It is still too wet.
4. The newly planted trees seem to be thriving.

New Business:

1. I'm working with Conserve Lake County in an effort to get the village certified by Conserve Lake County as a pilot restoration project. Hainesville would be the first village, as a whole, to receive that designation.
