Approval of January meeting minutes

Terry Grom reported that Robinson Engineering has moved into a office in Mc Henry. Things with Robinson are going very well. The water system has operated without incident, even during this sub zero weather that we can't seem to get rid of.

The budget has been turned in. We are awaiting the results from our requests.

The ever piling amount of snow is starting to take its hold on the Village salt supply. I have instructed our plowing vendor to salt intersections, curves and "hot" spots only. Salt companies are having issues trying to get salt up the rivers due to the ice. The demand for salt is so high right now, that if we wanted to get more it would cost us upwards of \$250.00 a ton. We currently pay \$57.00 a ton. We should be ok for the rest of the season if we follow the salting measures put forth.
