Discussed entertainment for fest which will be Jelly Bones Blues, Summit and Ray Herr (former Ides of March band member).

Talked about vendors such as Tastefully Simple, local businesses, crafters. The idea was brought up to put a note in the water bill asking the residents in our village if they would like to participate in a craft fair.

Children's activities would consist of Busy Brains, Balloon artist, possibly getting Holly Nagle to extend her time this year because she was very popular last year, hula hoop contest, balloon toss, sock hop.

Girl Scout Bake Sale contacting Cathy Pasarella to see if her girls would be interested if not maybe she would know of another local troop that would be interested. Also contacting a local boy scout troop to see if they would be interested in having a booth with information on how to become a boy scout, how to earn badges etc...

Budget items were discussed such as, the cost of a D.J. We are going to look into the D.J. that Frederick has for their rec nights, contact Officer Stang to see if she would be interested in doing something re: the

D.A.R.E. program, having a police dog demonstration, asking the Lake County Sheriff's office to come again this year with the "drunk driver glasses", patch 22 ponies, shirts for volunteers, Burris Equipment for generators and lights, port a johns, garbage dumpsters, tables, chairs, tents, possibility of catering a meal between certain hours, versus food vendors all day long. If we had vendors we would not need to pay out like

we would with a catering service. We are looking at the pros and cons on each subject.

We discussed having a chili cook-off this year, may put a note in the water bill. Will discuss more about this issue at the next committee meeting.

Also discussed having a bike contest again this year, we would do a \$20.00, \$15.00 and \$10.00 gift certificate from Toys R Us for the winners. Best dressed dog, getting a Petco gift certificate for the best dressed dog, Blessing of the pets, asking a priest from St. Gilberts to come over at a certain time and have those who want their pets blessed. Save-a-pet have kids bring canned dog food, old towels etc... and we would donate them to the shelter, the kids would then get some free tickets. These items will be discussed again at the next committee meeting.

Discussed catering options, charging a certain fee per person instead of having one vendor.

We discussed the Youth Build Lake County/5K walk/run, Jim spoke to Laurel and she stated that she would like to get involved but has been notified that they need to find a new spot to relocate, not sure if she can do a 5K run this year.

Also spoke to Clay with Avon Township Youth Baseball. He is possibly going to do a baseball tournament on the same day as the fest. Will also discuss about doing a raffle for A.T.Y.B with Clay being in charge of the raffle and all proceeds will go back to A.T.Y.B.

A-Awesome Amusements came up with 3 proposals. Climbing wall, generators, table top games, obstacle course, inflatable slide etc... More to be discussed at future meetings.

Meeting was adjourned at 8:50 p.m. The next meeting will be announced at a later date.
