Autumn Potpourri from the Building Official

Numerous yellow tags (warnings) have been issued to residents who are not maintaining their property according to village ordinance and/or the building code.

- ✓ Grass must be mowed and trimmed regularly.
- ✓ Garbage cans should only be stored on side yards, behind house or inside garage. Do not store cans in front of house or garage!
- ✓ Broken railings, garage doors, windows, shutters, etc. need to be repaired in a timely manner.
- ✓ Mowing or planting in conservation or wetland areas is strictly prohibited!
- ✓ Please check with the Village Hall before starting any home improvement project to make sure a permit is not required.
