Follow up on items brought up under new business at the last meeting.

1. George, Dave Criz and I accompanied Jeff on a walk around Cranberry Lake to identify drainage problem areas. Jeff will be addressing the drainage problems in the next few weeks.
2. Letters were sent to residents along Tall Oak, once again, addressing the problem of encroaching into the Conservancy.
3. I have created a map of the village with the wetlands named. They are distributed tonight at the meeting. (See attached.)
4. Mowing has been done along Hainesville and Washington roads. More timely mowing will be accomplished when we get our own tractor/mower.
5. Letters were sent to owners of vacant property in the village. Some owners have mowed their properties.
6. There is a spray available to deter geese. We must decide where we want it sprayed.

New Business:

Jeff will be able to erect stairs at the north side of the path by the Cranberry North Townhomes.

We discussed the need to send out a CTY call to residents alerting them to the week a burn is planned—weather permitting.

There was a suggestion that an article be put in the Hainesville newsletter asking residents help pick up trash around Cranberry Lake.

Meeting adjourned at 7:45 pm.
