

SWALCO Clothing and Textile Recycling Collection Box now in Hainesville

Hainesville is one of the first SWALCO sponsored clothing and textile collection bin drop-off locations. The program will accept new, gently used, used or unwanted/worn, women's, men's and children's clothing. All fabrics will be accepted. Even clothes or textiles with stains or holes will be accepted. The great news too, is that almost 95% of the materials collected will be repurposed or recycled.

The bin is located on the south side of the Public Works building next to the village hall off of Hainesville Road. SWALCO will be working with Chicago Textile Recycling, a Division of Wipeco, Inc. to recycle the items collected. Below is a list of acceptable and non-acceptable items that will be accepted through this program.

List of Acceptable Items for Clothing and Textile Bin:

Clothing Items: Blouses, Coats, Jackets, Dresses, Pants, Shirts, Socks, Swimsuits, Suits, Tuxedos, Sweaters, Undergarments, Ties, Socks, Jeans, Hats, Pet Clothing, Halloween Costumes, and Scarves.

Clothing Accessories: Purses, Handbags, Backpacks, Totebags, and Belts.

Household Textiles: Bedspreads, Sheets, Blankets, Drapes, Sofa Covers, Quilts, Towels, Table and Dining Cloths and Linens, Washcloths, Curtains, Comforters, and Duvets.

List of Unacceptable Items: Pillows, Sleeping Bags, Mattresses, Rugs, Carpet, Cushions, Foam Furniture, Foam Mats, Vinyl Shower Curtains, Large Luggage, Wet Items, Odorous or Moldy Items.
