AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 5.04.180 OF THE VILLAGE CODE AND REVISING THE BUSINESS LICENSE FEE SCHEDULE

WHEREAS, Section 5.04.180 of the Hainesville Village Code governs the business license fees and establishes a fee schedule for the Village of Hainesville; and

WHEREAS, the Village Board finds it necessary and desirable and in the best interest of the Village to revise those fees;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Board of Trustees of the Village of Hainesville, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1: The above-stated recitals are incorporated by reference.

SECTION 2: Section 5.04-180 of the Village Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

5.04.180 - Fee schedule.

License fees under the terms of this chapter, for the business, occupations, activities and uses set forth, shall be as provided in the fee schedule which is a part of this section. Fees listed in this schedule for businesses for which regulations are not contained in this code are nevertheless required to be paid as a condition to the operation of the business. License fees for the period of May 1st to April 30th must be paid by April 30th prior to the start of the New Business License Year, and proof of any bond or liability insurance policy required by this chapter or elsewhere in this code shall be provided with the license fee. Annual fees shall be reduced by 50% for new businesses that begin operation between January 1 and February 28.

SECTION 4: If any part of this Ordinance is found or determined to be invalid, the invalid portion shall be stricken herefrom and the remainder shall be in full force and effect.

SECTION 5: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval. This ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form.
