WHAT IS GOING ON WITH ROUTE 53?

Over the past two years Lake County participated in a collaborative Land Use Planning Process working with CMAP and corridor communities, which included the Village of Hainesville, to develop a broad land use strategy for the entire corridor. In November 2015, the Land Use Committee approved a motion to finalize and accept the IL Route 53/120 Corridor Land Use Strategy. In mid-December 2015, the Illinois Toll Highway Authority Board unanimously approved a resolution authorizing an Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) for the IL Route 53/120 project. The EIS will be conducted in two tiers and will take approximately four years to complete. An EIS will help answer many of the key questions regarding the type of road, where should it be built, how much will it really cost, environmental considerations and if any road should be built.

The EIS process will also include a robust public information and engagement program. Only then can we clearly decide whether it is the best option to improve quality of life, provide economic development and offer opportunity for additional and enhanced dedicated bus service and paratransit service. This need is most vital to the future and quality of life in Central and Western Lake County and the overall strength and stability of Lake County as a whole.

Many questions have been raised since headlines appeared with Aaron Lawlor's (Lake County Chairman) recent personal opinion statements changing his mind on Route 53 and in what he feels best suits his County District 18 (includes Kildeer and most of Hawthorn Woods). This does not supersede what is on the record at both the County and Municipal level. This project is currently at the Tollway Board level. Hainesville and many others have recently reaffirmed support of the EIS moving forward as soon as possible.

TALKING TRASH

White Goods/Appliances: Freon items are \$40.00 per item. Customer must call in by Tuesday 2:00 p.m. for Wednesday pick-up. This must be prepaid with a credit card. No charge for other appliances but you must schedule a pick-up.

One bulk item is allowed each week BUT must be manageable by driver (not to exceed over 50 lbs. and less than 5 ft. long). Larger bulk items must be called in for pick-up and will be a charged by size. These need to be prepaid also. Carpet must be rolled and tied with string, twine or duct tape. Each roll must be less than 5 ft. in length and not heavier than 50 lbs. Soaked carpet will not be picked-up!
