## **Building Permits Required**

A building permit is required for most projects. Please check the Village website or call the Village Hall to see if a permit is required for your project. The Building Department may take 7 to 10 days to review and process the application and plans but your project will go much smoother in the end. You as the property owner are ultimately responsible for obtaining the necessary permits. Do not rely on your contractor to do so or request them in a timely manner. If your contractor does handle getting the permit make sure they have it properly displayed **BEFORE** they begin work on your property!

We do not expect the residents to know all the codes and ordinances. It is the responsibility of the Building Department to help you if you are having trouble with something on your project. You should expect the contractors you hire to know and understand the codes. Their expertise is part of what you are paying for. If you have any question about what your contractor is telling you, please call the Village Hall and ask us. The Building Department will let you know what you should be looking for and what should be done. In working with contractors, remember to get references and never pay for a project up front!
