Fox Lake Sanitary Sewer District SEWER RATE INCREASE

All properties in Union Square Townhomes, Cranberry Lake (both Single Family Homes and all Townhomes) and the Commercial corridor on Routes 120 and 134 are within the Fox Lake Sanitary Sewer District. The District has declared a rate of service increase starting this January and will appear on your February bill and thereafter. The new increase is simply an increase in the rate of service and is as follows: Currently \$3.58 per 1,000 gallons will change to \$3.67 per 1,000 gallons (increase of nine cents per 1,000 gallons) effective January 1, 2017.
