Office, Zion City Hall)

April 3rd - **Last day for early voting at State mandated extended hour sites**(Gurnee Village Hall, Jane Addams Center, Lake County Courthouse and Administrative Complex, North Chicago City Hall)

April 4th - **ELECTION DAY** (All Hainesville residents vote at Hainesville Village Hall)
