Tuesday, June 20<sup>th</sup>, 4:00 p.m. – 7:00 p.m. in the Hainesville Village Hall parking lot, 100 N. Hainesville Road. Heartland will have a blood donation coach bus on site and each donor will receive a **\$5 Target gift card**. Heartland is the sole provider for 63 Chicagoland area hospitals and the Veterans Hospital.

### **Sewer Rate Increase**

Lake County Public Works Department has notified the Village that there will be a sewer rate increase due to rate modification by the North Shore Sewer District. This increase will be passed on to the residents. Effective June 1, 2017 all customers of the County's Northeast Central Sewer System (all of Deer Point Trails Subdivisions and Misty Hill Subdivision) will see this increase.

The first bill that will include this increase will be issued on July 17, 2017

For the residents living in Misty Hill Farms, Deer Point Trails, The Sanctuary and The Settlement, the sewer rate will increase from \$4.53 per thousand gallons to \$4.994 per thousand gallons. The total increase is \$0.464 per thousand gallons.

**New carpet is being installed later this month and will affect our hours of operation. We will be closed Monday, May 29<sup>th</sup> for the Memorial Day Holiday. On Tuesday, May 30<sup>th</sup> we are open from 9:00 a.m. to noon, on Thursday June 1<sup>st</sup> and Friday June 2<sup>nd</sup> we are closed. Use the grey drop box on the side of the Village Hall Building to make any utility payments etc. or go to our website.**
