## **SEWER RATE INCREASE!**

Lake County Public Works Department has notified the Village that there will be a sewer rate increase due to rate modification by the North Shore Sewer District. This increase will be passed on to the residents. Effective June 1<sup>st</sup>, 2017 all customers of the County's Northeast Central Sewer System (all of Deer Point Trails Subdivisions and Misty Hill Subdivision) will see this increase. The first bill that will include this increase will be issued on July 17<sup>th</sup>, 2017.

For the residents living in Misty Hill Farms, Deer Point Trails, The Sanctuary and The Settlement, the sewer rate will increase from \$4.53 per thousand gallons to \$4.994 per thousand gallons. The total increase is \$0.464 per thousand gallons.

## **ABOUT HEAT WAVES**

Excessive heat waves have caused more deaths than all other weather events, including floods. A heat wave is a prolonged period of excessive heat, generally 10 degrees or more above average, often combined with excessive humidity. Weather forecasters use these terms when a heat wave is predicted in your community:

**Excessive Heat Watch** - Conditions are favorable for an excessive heat event to meet or exceed local Excessive Heat Warning criteria in the next 24 to 72 hours.

**Heat Advisory** - Heat Index values are forecasting to meet locally defined advisory criteria for 1 to 2 days (daytime highs= 100-105° Fahrenheit).

**Excessive Heat Warning** - Heat Index values are forecasting to meet or exceed locally defined warning criteria for at least 2 days (daytime highs= 105-110° Fahrenheit).
