LEAF VACUUM SERVICES - YARD WASTE PICK-UP

Leaf vacuum service will be offered the last 6 weeks of yard waste pick-up, on Wednesdays, the same day as your trash, recycling and yard waste service starting 10/25. The last pick-up will be 11/29. Please be aware that due to the volume of leaves any particular week, the leaf collection truck may not always arrive at your home the same time each week. Please have your leaves ready for pick-up by 6:30 a.m. on Wednesdays.

INSTRUCTIONS: Residents should rake their leaves in a pile or row within 3 feet of the curb but remaining well off the street. Please make sure to keep the leaves on the parkway and not in the street. Please do not mix large tree branches, grass, or brush with your pile of leaves as these items will damage the vacuum truck. **If the weather won't cooperate & there is bad weather on a Wednesday, the leaves will be picked up the very next day or ASAP.**
