**DID YOU KNOW YOU CAN DO ALL OF THIS WITH YOUR VILLAGE UTILITY BILL?**

**SET UP CREDIT / DEBIT CARD RECURRING PAYMENTS** – This is the latest enhancement for payments. Our online payment processor, Point and Pay, now offers the option to set up a recurring electronic payment using a CREDIT or DEBIT CARD. Many residents have asked for this feature and it is now available! Set up your credit card account and earn those points!

**RECEIVE YOUR UTILITY BILL VIA EMAIL (PAPERLESS)** – Help your Village and environment by saving time and money with the costs of paper, envelopes, cartridge ink, postage and staff time. Your bill is emailed the day it is produced.

**SET UP AUTOMATIC DEBIT PAYMENTS** – You choose which account is used to pay your bill. A bill is produced and emailed/mailed so you know exactly how much will be deducted. Money is not taken out of your account until the due date! Avoid those penalties and sign up today!

**HAVE ONLINE ACCESS TO REVIEW YOUR UTILITY ACCOUNT AND TO MAKE A PAYMENT** – Misplaced your bill? You can review your account online to see your balance and review your history. Your PIN number is required to access your account. The PIN is on the Upper Right Hand Side of your Utility Bill or call the office for the PIN. While reviewing your account you may make your payment at this time as well.

## **SWALCO Information**

**Electronics do not belong in your regular trash and cannot be placed in your recycling cart either. All residential electronics may be dropped off at a special electronics recycling bin located at the Hainesville Public Works Department parking lot which is adjacent to the Village Hall.**

### **Clothing and Textiles Recycling**

**It is estimated that in the U.S. today, nearly 85% of all clothing and textiles end up in landfills. The EPA estimates that the average person throws away 70 pounds of clothing each year. Textile and clothing waste is a significant problem in our country. It is estimated that anywhere from 5-10% of all waste that is sent to municipal landfills is comprised of textiles. These items are often very dense and consume significant landfill space.**

**A special white bin just for clothing and textiles is available at the Hainesville Public Works Department on the southeast corner of the parking lot. The program will accept new, gently used, used or unwanted/worn, women's, men's and children's clothing and textiles. All fabrics will be accepted. Even clothes or textiles with stains or holes will be accepted. The great news is that almost 95% of the materials collected will be repurposed or recycled.**

**The clothing and textiles recycling program is a full-circle program. Your donations of new and gently used clothing and textiles - which will be reused - allow SWALCO to continue programs and recycle any worn-out/stained items we receive, turning them into usable new products!**

### **Reuse-A-Shoe Program**

**The Village of Hainesville now has a shoe collection receptacle in the lobby. Please tie or rubber band pairs together and drop them off during the hours that the Village is open. All sizes and brands, new, gently worn, and used/worn will be accepted. We will not accept moldy or wet shoes, ice skates, rollerblades and snow boots.**
