March 15th – Last day to request a ballot by mail.

March 17th - Last day for early voting at non-state mandated sites. (Antioch Twp. Office, Ela Twp. Office, Fremont Township Highway Department, Highland Park Police Station, Lake Barrington Village Hall, Lake County Central Permit Facility, Lake Forest City Hall, Round Lake Village Hall, William E. Peterson Park, West Deerfield Twp. Office, Zion City Hall)

March 19th - Last day for early voting at State mandated extended hour sites. (Gurnee Village Hall, Jane Addams Center, Lake County Clerk's Office, Lake County Courthouse and Administrative Complex, North Chicago City Hall)

March 20th - ELECTION DAY (All Hainesville residents vote at Hainesville Village Hall)

March 22nd - Voter registration reopens

DID YOU KNOW YOU CAN DO ALL OF THIS WITH YOUR VILLAGE UTILITY BILL?

SET UP CREDIT / DEBIT CARD RECURRING PAYMENTS – This is the latest enhancement for payments. Our online payment processor, Point and Pay, now offers the option to set up a recurring electronic payment using a CREDIT or DEBIT CARD. Many residents have asked for this feature and it is now available! Set up your credit card account and earn those points!



RECEIVE YOUR UTILITY BILL VIA EMAIL (PAPERLESS) – Help your Village and environment by saving time and money with the costs of paper, envelopes, cartridge ink, postage and staff time. Your bill is emailed the day it is produced.

SET UP AUTOMATIC DEBIT PAYMENTS – You choose which account is used to pay your bill. A bill is produced and emailed/mailed so you know exactly how much will be deducted. Money is not taken out of your account until the due date! Avoid those penalties and sign up today!

HAVE ONLINE ACCESS TO REVIEW YOUR UTILITY ACCOUNT AND TO MAKE A PAYMENT – Misplaced your bill? You can review your account online to see your balance and review your history. Your PIN number is required to access your account. The PIN is on the Upper Right Hand Side of your Utility Bill or call the office for the PIN. While reviewing your account you may make your payment at this time as well.
