## EMERALD ASH BORER TREE REPLACEMENT PROGRAM

As of the summer of 2018 the Village of Hainesville has completed the removal of all of our easement ash trees throughout the Village. The ash trees that were removed last year will be replaced by our contractor this fall. If you do not wish to have a replacement tree planted in the parkway, please contact the Village Hall.

The Village has also budgeted for the removal and replacement of some other damaged or dead parkway trees. If your tree is removed this year, it will be replaced next year. If you wish not to have a replacement, please contact the Village Hall.

The residents that have a tree to be removed this year will be informed by mail and given instructions of what needs to be done before removal of the tree. Once the letters are issued you can expect the tree to be removed within a few weeks.

Please note that work cannot be started until a permit is paid for and displayed. It is the resident's responsibility to make sure that a permit is applied for in our Village. Work begun and/or completed without a permit will be fined. Also, if during an Occupancy Inspection (inspections required when selling or renting a home), it is found that work has been done without a permit, the resident will need to go through the permitting process and pay the permit fee plus a penalty.
