March 6th – Grace period Registration at Lake County Clerk's Office, 18 N. County St., Room 101, Waukegan, IL 60085, 847-377-2400, Hours are Monday - Friday 8:30 a.m. – 5:00 p.m.

March 8th – Voting by mail begins. First day for early voting at the Lake County Clerk's Office.

- March 30th** – **Last day for early voting at non-state mandated sites** (Antioch Twp. Office, Ela Twp. Office, Fremont Public Library, Highland Park Police Station, Lake Barrington Village Hall, Lake County Central Permit Facility, Lake Forest City Hall, Round Lake Village Hall, Vernon Twp. Office and Zion City Hall)
- April 1st** – **Last day for early voting at State mandated extended hour sites.** (Gurnee Village Hall, Jane Addams Center, Lake County Courthouse & Administrative Complex, North Chicago City Hall)
- April 2nd** – **ELECTION DAY (All Hainesville residents vote at Hainesville Village Hall) For Hainesville, it is an uncontested race. There are 3 Candidates for 3 Trustee positions.**
- April 4th** – **Voter registration reopens**
