WETLAND CHANNELIZATION PROJECT TO START SETPEMBER 8TH, 2018

This project will improve the waterflow and the drainage of the Village's wetland areas.

This project involves digging channels in the wetlands south of Deer Lake Drive, east of White Tail Drive, north of Hunters Way, east of Deerview Drive and in the wetlands just east of Deer Point Drive. We will also be clearing away plants and trees that are currently blocking the drains. The channels will direct the water to the proper drain, which are located at the southeast corner of the Deer Lake wetlands and to the southwest corner of the Deer Point wetlands. This should greatly reduce the flooding for the homes that surround these wetlands.

The dredged material will be placed into commercial dumpsters that will be located near the work sites. The dumpsters are scheduled to be emptied on a daily basis. Unfortunately, there may be some odor given off by this material but since the project is scheduled to last only five days in each area, we hope this will not be too bothersome to you or your neighbors.

Part of this project was funded by the State through the help of Representative Sam Yingling.
